GATE NEWS

This year the state has greatly reduced the monies that fund the GATE (Gifted and Talented Education) program at Hemlock and throughout the district. Since the majority of differentiated instruction should occur in the regular classroom setting, this lack of funding does not affect this instruction. The afterschool classes are the ones that are being cut. GATE students and parents will be receiving a schedule of afterschool GATE classes in January 2010.
